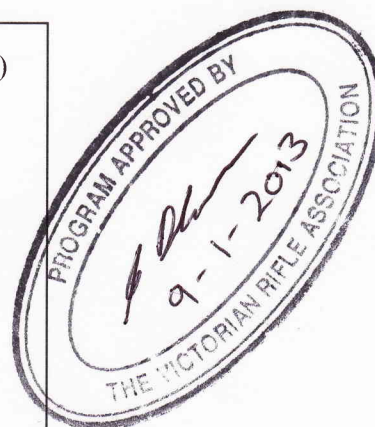
Novelty Event – Saturday, single shot (no sighters) at 1000 yards for a bottle of scotch – entry free.

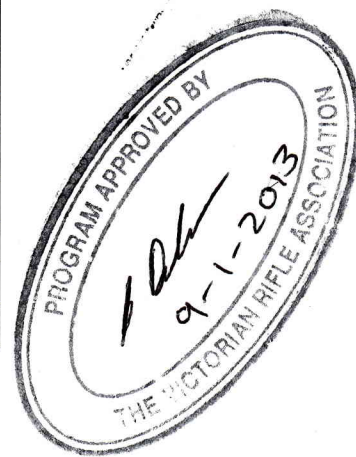
