Rosedale Rifle Range Zeroing and Testing Session Saturday 1 November 2014, 8am to 12 noon Free Admission

Rosedale Rifle Clubs are aware of the need for a place where sporting rifles can be tested and zeroed legally and safely in the La Trobe Valley and Sale region. We intend to run regular (monthly if sufficient demand) shooting sessions on Saturday mornings for bolt action centre fire rifles up to 8mm calibre. The first of these sessions will be held on Saturday November 1 starting at 8am and running till 12 noon, and for this one, admission will be free.

- Shooting will not be in a competition format, but at the shooters' own pace for the purposes of sighting in and testing.
- There will probably be a need for time limits to give everyone a fair go.
- For this opening day, shooting will be done from a distance of 200 yards to zeroing type targets which we will supply. Future shoots are intended to alternate between 100, 200 and 300 yards.
- Shooters are expected to bring their own rifles and ammunition.
- Centre fire rifles only and note the 8mm calibre limit. This rules out 338 calibre and above.
- Muzzle brakes will be allowed, although they may be allocated to separate sessions.
- Portable benches (some available from range) will be allowed.
- Shooters must bring their Shooters Licence and will need to sign an attendance book on arrival at the range.
- The event will be controlled by a qualified Range Officer, and safety rules will be enforced.
- During the session we will be talking to shooters about their future needs for this type of event.
